1. **Call to Order-** Mr. Josh Wilson opened with prayer.

Mrs. Christy Dryden will be going back to work in Technology at the Central Office.
 - B. **Financial/Resource Allocation-**Title I Federal Funds was released to the schools. The money was used to purchase chrome books, holder, and head phones for 3rd, thru 5th grades.
 - C. **Curriculum/ Instruction:** Dr. Witherspoon is considering a new software, Flocabulary (Hip-Hop style) to use with chrome books.
