1. **Call to Order-** Josh Purvis (Chairperson)
Mr. Purvis called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m., and opened up with prayer.
2. **Approval of Agenda**
Mr. Purvis presented the proposed agenda for Board approval. Ms. Daniels made a motion to accept proposed agenda. Ms. Hobbs made a second motion. All other members agreed by saying "I".
3. **Consensus for minutes from March 10, 2016 meeting**
Mr. Purvis asked for a consensus of the minutes. All members agreed on the minutes.
4. **Information items from the Principal**
 - A. **Personnel-**Mr. Purvis shared the news of two personnel changes for the 2016-17 school year. There is a Kindergarten position open. Ms. Amanda Holt accepted a teaching position in Cook County where she lives. There is a Third grade position open. Ms. Bennet has accepted a teaching position in Tift County where she lives. The board has approved for Stringfellow and four other schools to have an Academic Coach for the new school year. Mr. Purvis was confident this will make a positive impact in the future development of the students.
 - B. **Financial/Resource Allocation-** No new information to be presented.
 - C. **End of Year Procedures-** Teachers/students have worked extremely hard on testing, RTI, Interventions, and entering Data for the end of the year.
 - D. **Milestone Retest-** Mr. Purvis shared with the team members that the Board of Education approved the recommendation from the State to waive the Retest/Retention Requirements from the Georgia Milestones. Students/Teachers will resume their normal schedules effective immediately
 - E. **Data Presentation-** Mr. Purvis presented a power point comparing Data from 2014-2015 to present. The data consisting from Faculty and student absences and tardies were significantly lower this year compared to the 2014-15 school year. Mr. Purvis also shared Stringfellow's CCRPI Score went up by 10 points, which is Great News! The scores were released later than usual. He said, the scores for 2015-16 school year should be released in October 2016.

He is very hopeful the score will be even higher, according to the data he shared from the power point presentation. Stringfellow increased scores in all areas.

With no further items from the Local School Governance Team or from the Executive Session, Mr. Purvis adjourned the meeting. This concludes the required meetings for the 2015-16 school year. The next LSGT meeting will be scheduled at a date to be announced when the 2016-17 school year begins in August.
